#10-12 are open-ended questions, and will have varying answers.

1.

What made Bobo's heart thump faster at dawn?

Bobo's heart thumped faster because he saw a strange, soft light pulsing from outside his window that felt wrong.

2.

How did the mysterious light make the lush forest feel different?

The light made the dewy leaves glimmer with an unnatural glow and made Bobo feel like he was walking into a dream or a secret, not just an ordinary morning walk.

What was special and a little scary about the enormous tree with gnarled branches?

It was an enormous ancient tree, much bigger and older than any Bobo had seen. Its gnarled branches were twisted like shadowy arms, and the strange pulsing light came from a tiny, hidden hole at its base, which felt a bit scary.

What specific promise did Bobo make with strong resolve to the vines to make them move?

Describe the terrible vision Bobo saw inside the sparkling crystal. What did it show?
