2. How did Sparky feel when he couldn't breathe fire?

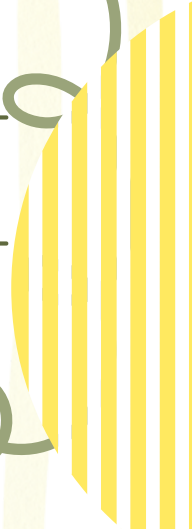
3. What did Sparky see outside that made him leave the warm cave?

Answer Key
