Use **Didn't** to make a negative question about the past. The verb must be in its base form.

1. You bought new and expensive shoes at the store.

(Negative Question: about buying new shoes)

(Negative Question: about helping find the bear)

(Negative Question: about deciding to close the school)

(Negative Question: about chewing the chair)

10. The sun shone brightly all day long on the beautiful beach. (Negative Question: about shining brightly)



11. He worried a lot about the outcome of the big competition. (Negative Question: about worrying)




15. We explained the new game rules carefully to the younger children. (Negative Question: about explaining the rules)
